Who Should Attend This Workshop?

This workshop is recommended for all staff that provides goods, services or facilities to the public. The workshop will ensure that every staff employee is trained on all required elements of the Integrated Accessibility Standards.

How Long?

This is a 90 minute training program which allows for 50 people at a time to be trained.

Overview

The new Integrated Accessibility Standards Regulation has established specific standards; Information & Communications, Employment, Transportation and Public Spaces as part of the Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act, 2005 (AODA).

This regulation applies to public, private, and not-for-profit businesses and organizations that provide goods, services or facilities either directly to the public or to other businesses or organizations, and have at least one employee in Ontario.

Businesses and organizations must ensure training is provided on the requirements of the Integrated Accessibility Standards referred to in this regulation and on the Human Rights Code as it pertains to persons with disabilities.

- Understand that policies, procedures and practices are in place to support the Integrated Accessibility Standards.
- Understand the Human Rights Code as it pertains to persons with disabilities.
- Understand how the Accessibility Standard for Information and Communications will help organizations to effectively communicate and provide information to people with disabilities.
- Understand how the Accessibility Standard for Employment will help organizations to recruit, accommodate and retain people with disabilities in our labour force.
- Understand how the Accessibility Standard for Transportation will make public transit more accessible for people with disabilities.
- Understand how Public Spaces will affect new service counters, outdoor spaces and trails.
- Understand how the legislation contributes to the goal of an accessible Ontario.
